

Instructions for coming to the church for Sunday services

We are really looking forward to seeing you on Sunday. So that everyone has a safe visit to church we would be very grateful if you could read and observe the instructions below.

1. Please arrive at church no more than 20 minutes before the start of the service. Please be aware that if you arrive after the service has started your place might have been given to someone else. Only come if you are feeling well and show no symptoms of COVID19.
2. You will need to enter the church via the Holmes Ave Entrance. If there is a queue to get in, please queue 2 metres apart (there will be 2 metre markings on the ground).
3. Give your name to the member of the welcome team with the clipboard.
4. On entering, use the hand sanitiser provided.
5. For Track and Trace purposes a record will be taken of who sits in each seat. So, please give your name to the duty warden and they will allocate you a seat.
6. Make your way straight to the seat following the markings, not touching any chairs. Leave a gap of 4 chairs (which is 2m) between you/ your group and the next person/ group. Once in your seat remain there until the end of the service. Do not greet others with a friendly wave, but do keep 2 metres apart. Please don't change chairs.
7. Please note there will be no bibles available, so bring your own if you wish to use one. You may also wish to bring a notebook and pen (there will be no "paperwork" provided).
8. At the end of the service you will be instructed when to leave – which will be through the Holmes Ave door. Use the hand sanitiser again as you leave.
9. We would prefer you not to use the toilet, but the disabled toilet is available if required (use the front side door near the pulpit, and maintain 2 metres from people en route). The kitchen and all other areas of the church are not available for use.
10. **Masks are mandatory** (except those under the age of 11 or have special exemption)
11. There will be no offertory boxes available, but if you would like to donate to the church, please contact the church office.
12. While moving around the church building (including as you leave) please keep 2 metres apart (there will be 2 metre marks on the floor). Please don't unnecessarily touch any surfaces. In the event of a fire/ emergency, social distancing is not required until it is safe to do so again.
13. For Track and Trace purposes, if you become unwell with Covid symptoms within 48 hours of visiting the church building you must let the church office know ASAP.

Please be aware that anyone attending a service at Bishop Hannington church does so at their own risk.
