Thank you so much for your prayers, cards and thoughts for Fran's knee operation on July 1st. She stayed in hospital for physiotherapy until July 13th. Fran still has weekly physio, daily exercises and is now the proud owner of an exercise bike. Over this whole time Fran has continued to have opportunities to talk about God's faithfulness, love and provision. Mostly through WhatsApp or text messages, emails or the phone and occasionally with real face to face conversations.

Give thanks for the wonderful care she has received, both in hospital and now. P*lease continue to pray* for Fran's recovery. This has been a difficult time. She had no idea that it would be so painful or debilitating. 6 weeks after the operation and she is still limited in how far she can walk and what she can do. She hasn't slept properly since before the operation.

Last week Martin had an appointment with Carlotta, his rheumatologist. Since being diagnosed in 2017 Martin has had a mixture of good and bad periods with his autoimmune disease, vasculitis. But he explained to Carlotta that since October he has been struggling continually with lack of energy and painful joints and legs. She has now prescribed a different medication, an injection every two weeks. *Give thanks* for Carlotta and her care for Martin and *please pray* that this new treatment will make a difference to Martin's quality of life.

Florence, where we live, is almost deserted. Most Italians go away in August so many of our local shops are shut while the owners take a well deserved break. July and August are usually very hot and humid so we have been taking advantage of the early morning cool air to take Gioia for a walk at around 7.30!!! All of us walk to the bar, same one every morning, pick up a coffee and croissant and sit in the nearby park. We talk about our plans for the day, pray for them and our family and friends, and chat to any of our dog walking friends who pass by. They always make a big fuss of Gioia, so she is happy too. Then Martin goes off for a longer walk with Gioia and Fran goes home.



Give thanks for this wonderful start to the day and **please pray** that we will get opportunities to live out our faith with our dog walking friends.

Other things to give thanks for:

- Our holiday in Tuscany in June. 10 days of complete relaxation and fun with Gioia
- Fran had a lovely chat with her mother last week. They have decided that April 2022 is a good time to next visit the UK and spend time together. It will coincide with her 94th birthday
- Fran especially wants to give thanks for Martin and his care for her. Nothing has been too much trouble for him. He really is a treasure.
